Dear NMB,

The DanceSport discipline Breaking, governed by the World DanceSport Federation, was officially added to program of the Olympic Games Paris 2024 as a medal sport following a decision of the International Olympic Committee's Executive Board in the session that took place in December 2020. Thus, we officially confirm that Breaking is an Olympic Sport.

Breaking made its first appearance at the Youth Olympic Games Buenos Aires 2018 and it has also been included into the programme of the Youth Olympic Games Dakar 2026.

The disciplines under the WDSF umbrella are listed in our *WDSF Competition Rules* available on our website (www.wdsf.org). These include, but not limited to, Standard and Latin-American dances (including 10-Dance, Formations, Team Matches, Teacher-Student competitions, ShowDance and Smooth Dance), Rock'n'Roll and Boogie-Woogie, Urban Dances (including Hip-Hop and Breaking), Performing, Stage and Theatre Dances, Disco Dance, Caribbean Dances, Artistic Group DanceSport, and Folkloric Dances.
